Team Doubles (Match 1) and Team Doubles Rattle Battle (Match 2)
March 4, October 7

LOCATION: Oak Ridge Sportsman's Association , Oak Ridge, Tennessee

ELIGIBILITY: Open. Each team will consist of two firing members. Minimum of 5 teams to hold Match 1, minimum of 10 teams to invoke the handicap rule for Match 1. Match 2 any number of teams may compete up to range capacity.

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets and/or score for other relays.

CHALLENGES: A fee of one Dollar will be charged in advance for each challenge.

FEES: Match 1 : \$20.00 per team Match 2 is a practice/fun match.

ENTRIES: Entries accepted up to range capacity and squadding will be done on the range beginning at 11am Firing to commence at noon.

RIFLE: Match 1: service or match rifles NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 or 3.3

Match 2: service rifles only NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3.

SIGHTS: All matches, metallic sights only

AMMUNITION: NRA Rule 3.17a&b, furnished by the competitor.

TARGETS: SR, SR3, and MR1 targets will be used.

AWARDS: To be announced. No team will receive more than one award. Winner to be determined by the results of Match 1.

Match 1

Rules: Current CMP Hearst Doubles Rifle Team rules (CMP Rule 8.7) will apply except as follows:

- No 3rd party coaches allowed except for junior teams. Team members may however coach each other.
- Experimental Handicap rule 8.7.5 will not apply, instead the handicap rule shall be:
- Individuals will be assigned a handicap value based on their NRA classification. Team handicap will be the sum of the individuals handicaps and will be added to the team's final score when the handicap rule is in force. Individual handicaps will be assigned based on the following scale: HM – 0 points, MA (UM) – 3 points, EX – 6 points, SS – 11 points, MA – 16 points. The handicap is the total for the entire match, not per stage.

Course Of Fire: 30 shot Presidents course with 2 sighters per stage

200yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 10 shots each (must pair fire) 27 minute time limit.

300yds, rapid fire, standing to prone, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 2 minutes for sighters, 70 seconds for 10 shots

600yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 10 shots each (must pair fire) 27 minute time limit.

No equipment or ammunition alibis or refires will be allowed. CMP Rule 5.1.2 is in effect (NRA Rules apply)

Match 2

Rules: Current CMP Infantry Trophy Team rules (CMP Rule 8.5) will apply except as follows:

- Teams will consist of two firing members, no 3rd party coaches except junior teams
- Each team will be permitted 96 rounds, to be allocated between members as the team chooses
- 4 targets per team will be utilized
- Scopes and/or binoculars may be used by the team members

Course Of Fire:

600yds, prone, 2 sighters followed by 50 seconds rapid fire

300yds, sitting, 2 sighters followed by 50 seconds rapid fire

200yds, standing, 2 sighters followed by 50 seconds rapid fire

No equipment or ammunition alibis or refires will be allowed. CMP Rule 5.1.2 is in effect (NRA Rules apply)

Hit values and bonus points will be calculated per CMP rule 8.5.4

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light no. 16 at Nebraska Ave.
