

**Oak Ridge Sportsmens Association
Civilian Marksmanship Program
John C. Garand Matches**

DATES: March 16, July 20, September 21, and November 15, 2008
Registration from 10:00 to 10:30 am; Firing begins 11:00 am.

LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95), 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light No. 16 at Nebraska Ave.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all US citizens at least 14 years of age. First time competitors not holding a current NRA HP Rifle classification card must complete at least one CMP Service Rifle clinic before firing a CMP Garand or Springfield match. Participation enables all qualified competitors to purchase rifles authorized under the CMP Rifle sales program (see www.odcmp.com for details). CMP certificates of competition will be issued to all competitors at the conclusion of the match upon request.

RULES: Current CMP Competition Rules will apply.

All competitors must make reservations at least one day in advance to allow for adequate ammunition support.

SQUADDING: All competitors must check in at the ORSA Clubhouse at least one hour prior to the start of the match (10:00 am) to receive a relay and target assignment and to be issued ammo. Competitors needing to share the same rifle will be accommodated whenever possible.

SCORING AND PIT OPERATION: Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

RIFLE: As Issued US .30 Caliber Rifle (CMP Rule 6.2.4). M1 Garand, M1903 Springfield, M1917 Enfield, M1941 Johnson, or M1 Carbine are allowed. Rifles must conform in weight and dimensions to the standard issue service rifle and must have not less than a 4.5 pound trigger pull. Rebarreling with a barrel of as-issued dimensions is allowed. No other alterations such as glass bedding, fitting of National Match parts, or use of synthetic stocks are allowed.

AMMUNITION: M2 ball ammunition will be issued. No handloads or commercial ammunition may be used.

COURSE OF FIRE: Course A (Table 7). All stages are fired from the 200 yard line on the SR target:

Stage 1 - Prone, slow fire, 5 sighter shots and 10 record shots, 15 minutes.

Stage 2 - Prone from Standing, rapid fire, 10 shots, 70 seconds.

Stage 3 - Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes.

Following completion of Course A competitors will have the opportunity to fire the John C. Garand Infantry Match: Competitors will move to the 300 yd line and will fire 5 sighter shots, prone, slow fire, on the "F" silhouette target. Competitors will be issued an additional 48 rounds of ammunition in clips. Competitors will fire prone, rapid fire, in a 50 second time limit. Hits on the "F" silhouette will count 3 points each. Competitors will walk to the 200 yd line. Competitors will fire sitting, rapid fire, in a 50 second time limit. Hits on the "F" silhouette will count 2 points each. Competitors will fire standing, rapid fire, in a 50 second time limit. Hits on the "F" silhouette will count 1 point each.

CHALLENGES: A fee of \$1.00 will be charged in advance for each challenge.

AWARDS: Awards will be made to recognize the Match Winner and the high scoring New Shooter (no NRA classification).
