

BIG ED'S REGISTERED HIGH POWER TOURNAMENT

May 1-3, 2009

An NRA Registered High Power Rifle Tournament

SPONSOR: Oak Ridge Sportsmens Association

LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee

RULES: Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules will apply

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all NRA members

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification will be used. NRA members must provide their membership number for classification purposes. Unclassified competitors will fire in a separate class if 5 or more compete. Otherwise unclassified competitors will be combined with the Master class.

CATEGORIES: Civilian and Service

FEES: CMP EIC Leg Match or Warmup Match \$20 adults / \$10 juniors
Individual Package (Matches 1-5): \$40 adults / \$20 juniors
Team Match (Match 6): \$40 per team

Entries will be accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay each day.

RIFLE: NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3, or 3.3 in Matches 1-6.

SIGHTS: Metallic sights only.

AMMUNITION: NRA Rule 3.17 a&b, furnished by the competitor.

TARGETS: SR, SR-3, and MR-1 targets will be used.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded, beginning at 8:00 am Friday and 7:30 am Saturday

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

CHALLENGES: A fee of \$2.00 will be charged IN ADVANCE for each challenge.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

Friday, 10:00 AM

CMP Service Rifle EIC Match

Course of Fire: The National Match Course, no sighting shots.

Arms: The Service Rifle. M1, M14, or M16, or civilian equivalent, consistent with current CMP Competition Rules.

Ammunition: Provided by the competitor. Service, commercial, or handloaded caliber .30, 7.62mm, or 5.56mm ammunition consistent with current CMP Competition Rules is authorized.

Rules: Current CMP Competition Rules.

Awards: Provided by CMP.

A **Competitor Warmup Match** will be fired concurrently with the CMP EIC Match, following the same course of fire. The **Warmup Match** is open to all individual competitors, using either the Match Rifle or the Service Rifle.

Saturday, 9:00 AM

Match 1 - 200 yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes

Match 2 - 200 yds, rapid fire, standing to sitting, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 60 seconds per 10 shot string

Match 3 - 300 yds, rapid fire, standing to prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 70 seconds per 10 shot string

Match 4 - 600 yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes

Match 5 - Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-4

Sunday, 9:00 AM

Match 6 - Four Man Team Match. National Match Course, 50 shots per firing member. Two sighting shots will be fired before each stage. Pair firing will be optional.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: NRA award points to match winners in the Warmup Match and Matches 1-5. Additional place awards in classes and categories for every 5 competitors registered. Categories with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined within class. Classes with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. No competitor will receive more than one award in any match.

TEAM AWARDS: NRA award points to the winning team. First place awards to the high team in each class and category, provided that 5 or more teams compete. Place awards will be made for every 5 additional teams within a class / category.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95), 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light No. 16 at Nebraska Ave.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES: A Competitor Cookout will take place at the ORSA Clubhouse immediately after the completion of firing on Saturday afternoon. Big Ed's Pizza will also host a Pizza Party on Sunday afternoon following the Team Match.
