**LOCATION:** Oak Ridge, Tennessee

**RULES:** Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules apply

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open

**CLASSIFICATION:** NRA classification will be used. NRA members must provide their membership number for classification purposes. Unclassified competitors will fire in a separate class if 5 or more compete. Otherwise, unclassified competitors will be combined with the master class.

**CATEGORIES:** Civilian and Service

**FEES:** Sunday Package (Matches 1-5): \$20.00 (NRA Junior members \$10.00)

**ENTRIES:** Entries accepted up to range capacity and squadding will be done on the range beginning at 10am Firing to commence at 11am.

**RIFLE:** NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 or 3.3 in Matches 1-5

**SIGHTS:** Metallic sights only in matches 1-5.

**AMMUNITION:** NRA Rule 3.17a&b, furnished by the competitor.

**TARGETS:** SR, SR3, and MR1 targets will be used.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded.

**SCORING:** Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

**CHALLENGES:** A fee of one Dollar will be charged in advance for each challenge.

**MATCH SCHEDULE:** Sunday 11:00am

Match 1 – 200yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 12 minutes.

Match 2 – 200yds, rapid fire, standing to sitting, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 60 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 3 – 300yds, rapid fire, standing to prone, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 70 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 4 – 600yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes.

Match 5 – Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-4.

**Note:** This is not an NRA approved match thus CMP style rapid fire rules will apply

**DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE:** The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light no. 16 at Nebraska Ave.
