ELIGIBILITY: Open. Each team will consist of two firing members.

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets and/or score for other relays.

CHALLENGES: A fee of one Dollar will be charged in advance for each challenge.

FEES: \$20.00 per team

ENTRIES: Entries accepted up to range capacity and squadding will be done on the range beginning at 10am Firing to commence at 11am.

RIFLE: service or match rifles NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 or 3.3

SIGHTS: All matches, metallic sights only

AMMUNITION: NRA Rule 3.17a&b, furnished by the competitor.

TARGETS: SR, SR3, and MR1 targets will be used.

AWARDS: To be announced. No team will receive more than one award.

Rules: Current CMP Hearst Doubles Rifle Team rules (CMP Rule 8.7) will apply except as follows:

- No 3rd party coaches allowed except for junior teams. Team members may however coach each other.
- Pair firing is optional
- Experimental Handicap rule 8.7.5 will not apply. Individuals will be assigned a handicap value based on their NRA classification. Team handicap will be the sum of the individuals handicaps and will be added to the team's final score. Individual handicaps will be assigned based on the following scale: HM – 0 points, MA (UM) – 3 points, EX – 6 points, SS – 11 points, MK – 16 points. The handicap is the total for the entire match, not per stage.

Course Of Fire: 50 shot NMC course with 2 sighters per stage

200yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 10 shots each (pair firing optional) 27 minute time limit.

200yds, rapid fire, standing to sitting, 2 sighters and 10 shots each, 2 minutes for sighters, 60 seconds for 10 shots

300yds, rapid fire, standing to prone, 2 sighters and 10 shots each, 2 minutes for sighters, 70 seconds for 10 shots

600yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots each (pair firing optional) 27 minute time limit.

No equipment or ammunition alibis or refires will be allowed. CMP Rule 5.1.2 is in effect (NRA Rules apply)

If team squadding cannot be worked out, match will be held as an individual match. Course of fire may be adjusted by match director depending upon participation.

Note: This is not an NRA approved match

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light no. 16 at Nebraska Ave.
