

**Oak Ridge Sportsman Association
Civilian Marksmanship Program
M1 Carbine Matches 2009**

DATES: March 22, Sept 20, Nov 1, Nov 15, 2009 **START TIME:** 12:00 p.m.

LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95), 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stoplight No. 16 at Nebraska Ave.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all US citizens at least 12 years of age. Participation enables all qualified competitors to purchase Civilian Marksmanship Rifles (CMP) Rifle Sales Program. Providing all additional requirements are met.

RULES: Current CMP Competition Rules will apply.

SQUADDING: All competitors must check in at the Statistical Office at least one hour prior to the start of the match to receive a relay and target assignment. Competitors needing to share the same rifle will be accommodated whenever possible.

SCORING AND PIT OPERATION: Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

RIFLE: As Issued US M1 or M1A1 Carbine (CMP Rule 6.2.6). Rifles must conform in weight and dimensions to the standard issue service rifle and must have not less than a 4.5-pound trigger pull. Rebarreling with a barrel of as-issued dimensions is allowed. **Standard-issue 15-round magazines or magazines with the same shape and configuration must be used. 30-round magazines may not be used.** No other alterations such as glass bedding, fitting of National Match parts, or use of synthetic stocks are allowed.

AMMUNITION: All competitors must provide their own safe ammunition in accordance with Rule 6.6.1.

COURSE OF FIRE: CMP Rule 9.5.1 Table 9. All stages are fired from the 100-yard line on the SR-1 highpower 200 yard reduced for firing at the 100-yard line rifle target:

Stage 1 - Prone, slow fire, 10 max sighter shots and 10 record shots, 15 minutes.

Stage 2 - Prone from standing, rapid fire, 10 shots, 60 seconds.

Stage 3 - Sitting or Kneeling from Standing, rapid fire, 10 shots, 60 seconds.

Stage 4 - Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes.

CHALLENGES: A fee of \$ 1.00 will be charged in advance for each challenge.

AWARDS: Achievement awards will be given in accordance with CMP Rule 9.5.4 (2). M1 Carbine achievement award scores for the 2009 competition year are:

Gold: 351 and above

Silver: 338-350

Bronze: 322-337
