**SPONSOR:** Oak Ridge Sportsman's Association

**LOCATION:** Oak Ridge, Tennessee

**RULES:** Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules apply

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open

**CLASSIFICATION:** NRA classification will be used. NRA members must provide their membership number for classification purposes. Unclassified competitors will fire in a separate class if 5 or more compete. Otherwise, unclassified competitors will be combined with the master class.

**CATEGORIES:** Civilian and Service

**FEES:** Saturday Package (Matches 1-5): \$20.00 (NRA Junior members \$10.00)

Sunday Package (Matches 6-10): \$20.00 (NRA Junior members \$10.00)

Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay each day. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

**RIFLE:** NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 or 3.3 in Matches 1-10

**SIGHTS:** Metallic sights only in matches 1-10.

**AMMUNITION:** NRA Rule 3.17a&b, furnished by the competitor.

**TARGETS:** SR, SR3, and MR1 targets will be used.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded.

**SCORING:** Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

**CHALLENGES:** A fee of one Dollar will be charged in advance for each challenge.

**MATCH SCHEDULE:**

Saturday 9:00am

Match 1 – 200yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes.

Match 2 – 200yds, rapid fire, sitting, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 60 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 3 – 300yds, rapid fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 70 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 4 – 600yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes.

Match 5 – Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-4.

Sunday 11:00am

Match 6 – 200yds, slow fire, standing, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 12 minutes.

Match 7 – 200yds, rapid fire, sitting, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 60 seconds.

Match 8 – 300yds, rapid fire, prone, 2 sighters and 10 shots, 70 seconds.

Match 9 – 600yds, slow fire, prone, 2 sighters and 20 shots, 22 minutes.

Match 10 – Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 6-9.

**\*\*\*SPECIAL NOTICES\*\*\***

**Sunday October 3<sup>rd</sup>** has been designated as the ORSA M14/M1A match. To be eligible for awards in this match the M14 (M1A) rifle (rule 3.1.1) or the M1 Garand (rule 3.1) must be used. Note that Garand rifles with NM modifications such as glass bedding and NM parts will be allowed. Garand rifles may be chambered for either .30-06 or .308

**Saturday November 6<sup>th</sup>** has been designated as the ORSA Fall Finale. This will be a Rifleman's Match. There will be no sighters, no alibis and no refires. May the best Rifleman win.

**AWARDS:** NRA award points to match winners in Matches 1-5 and Match 10. Additional place awards in classes and categories for every 5 competitors registered. Categories with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined within class. Classes with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. No competitor will receive more than one award in any match.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE:** The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light no. 16 at Nebraska Ave.
